This week we will be "setting the table" before General Conference begins on April 23th. There will be 862 clergy and lay delegates from 4 continents around the world meeting in Charlotte, NC from April 23rd to May 3rd. This group meets every four years (except for the past few years due to Covid) and there will be "live" sessions that anyone can watch in the second part of the conference.

The Staff/Parish Relations Committee is pleased to announce that the Rev. Dr. Darren M. McClellan has been appointed as Senior Pastor for Ashland Place UMC. Many of you already know Dr. McClellan and his wife, Kristi, as Ashland Place was his first appointment following Seminary. He served as our Associate Pastor from 2001-2006. Dr. McClellan grew up attending Shalimar UMC, and answered God's call into the ministry while attending Blue Lake as a teen. He received his undergraduate degree from the University of Florida (1998), an M.Div from the Candler School of Theology at Emory University (2001) and a D.Min from Princeton Theological Seminary (2010). He was ordained as an elder in The Alabama-West Florida Conference in 2004.

Darren and his wife, Kristi, have three sons--Joshua, John, and Max. Joshua is majoring in engineering at Central Florida University, and John and Max attend Spanish Fort High School. Kristi is a grant writer for Embrace Allabama's Children - UMC Children's Homes. Dr. McClellan's first Sunday at Ashland Place will be July 7th and we will host a welcome reception for his family.

Rev. Dr. Sterling Boykin has been appointed to serve the Southeastern District of our Annual Conference which ranges from Valley, AL, down the eastern side of Alabama to below Dothan. He and Lee Ann will be moving to the Dothan area at the end of June. Sterling's last Sunday in our pulpit is June 16th, with a reception at 10:00.
